SUBJECT: Updated Brochure B0105, Wisconsin Tuition Programs for Veterans, Qualifying Spouses, and Children

The brochure B0105, Wisconsin Tuition Programs for Veterans, Qualifying Spouses, and Children, has been updated and posted to the WDVA website at www.WisVets.com/Forms#WDVAB0105.

You will notice the following changes to the brochure:

- Contact information changes to the CVSO, UW and WTCS Veteran School Certifying Officials offices.
- Informing National Guard members to consider using their National Guard Tuition grant while eligible.
- New statutory language.
- Residency for Tuition Purposes for Children, Spouses and Unremarried Spouses step explained.
- Explanation that usage of Post 9/11 Chapter 33 Federal benefits at a WTCS or UWS institution will no longer count against your State of Wisconsin 128 WI G.I. Bill totals since under new legislation these credits were restored.
- Explanation to applicants that this is a two step process in that WDVA only certifies the veteran as eligible and it is the school that approves the student be it veteran, eligible Unremarried Spouse, or eligible child for the tuition remission.
- Updated VetEd language.
