Dear King Members, Friends, and Family:

I'd like to start by sharing a little information with you today. There are currently nearly 28,000 ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 in the state. Just yesterday, 3,403 new coronavirus cases in 69 of Wisconsin's 72 counties were reported. Yes, distribution and administration of the vaccine has begun, but we need more time and more people to receive it for it to take its full effect. In the meantime, we must all continue to observe all of our COVID-19 safety practices.

Since my update yesterday, we've had two members test positive for COVID-19. There are no new positive cases among employees. Currently there are eight active positive cases of COVID-19 on campus (six members, two employees).

Please continue to be vigilant in protecting yourself and others against the virus. Stay safe by limiting gatherings, maintaining six feet of distance from others when going out, wearing a mask, and washing hands regularly.
