This week, the 1,000,000th COVID-19 case was reported in Wisconsin. Racine County is experiencing a critically high COVID-19 case activity level. Please help us to stop the spread of the virus and protect those who are living on our campus.

Since we updated you on January 3, we have had 3 employees and 2 members test positive for COVID-19. Currently, we have 20 total cases of COVID-19 on campus (3 members, 17 employees).

Finally, if you are feeling sick, get tested. Whether you have COVID-19, the flu, or something else, a proper diagnosis gets you treatment faster and protects everyone around you. Continue to wear a mask when out, remain six feet away from others, avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces, wash your hands frequently, and get vaccinated.
