Dear Union Grove Members, Friends, and Family:

All of Wisconsin and Racine County continue to experience critically high levels of COVID-19 and the Omicron variant. We urge everyone to take extra precautions to keep yourself and your loved ones safe.

Since we last updated you on January 14, we have had 7 employees and 3 members test positive for COVID-19. Currently, we have 33 cases of COVID-19 on campus (7 members, 26 employees).

Please do your part by wearing a mask, remaining six feet away from others, avoid gatherings, large crowds, poorly ventilated spaces, wash your hands frequently, and get a vaccine and booster shot.
