The COVID cases in Wisconsin continue to rise, so we urge everyone to take extra precautions to keep yourself and your loved ones safe during this surge of the Omicron variant. All of Wisconsin's 72 counties continue to be in critically high in community transmission.

Since we last updated you yesterday, we have had 7 employees test positive for COVID-19. Currently, we have 60 cases of COVID-19 on campus (7 members, 53 employees).
