Since my update on January 19th, we've had one employee test positive for COVID-19. There are no new positive cases among members. Currently there are nine active positive cases of COVID-19 on campus (five members, four employees).

While the seven-day average of cases in the state is declining, unfortunately, community spread of the virus remains very high in Waupaca and surrounding counties. Please continue safe practices that help protect against the virus such as avoiding gatherings, maintaining six feet of distance from others when going out, wearing a mask, and washing hands regularly.

As a reminder for those not on campus, I'd also like to encourage you to learn more about how you can be vaccinated in your community.
