As we continue to see a surge in COVID-19 cases in the state, we are also seeing cases of COVID-19 here on campus. Waupaca County continues to show a critically high COVID-19 case level activity.

Since we updated you on January 24, we have had 2 members and 3 employees test positive for COVID-19. Accounting for member and employee recoveries, we currently have 46 active cases of COVID-19 on campus (9 members, 37 employees).

We are immensely proud of the resilience, flexibility, and professionalism of our staff – especially our activities directors, skilled nurses, food service workers and custodial employees - who have stayed focused on caring for our members' health and wellbeing during these unprecedented times.
