We hope you and your loved ones are staying healthy. The Omicron variant of COVID-19 continues to take a toll, as all 72 of Wisconsin's counties remain in critically high transmission for the virus.

Since we updated you yesterday, we have had 4 employees test positive for COVID-19. Accounting for member and employee recoveries, we currently have 45 active cases of COVID-19 on campus (9 members, 36 employees).

While we permit visitors, we ask that anyone who feels ill or has any symptom of COVID-19 to postpone their visit and get tested before visiting. While you are visiting with your loved ones, please wear an N95 or KN95 face mask, practice healthy physical distancing, and limit your movement throughout our care community as much as possible. Together, we can all prevent the spread of the virus into our Home.
