On Wednesday, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services reported the lowest daily COVID-19 case level since August 2021. While we are thankful for this positive news, we ask you to please continue to be vigilant in your daily routine as the virus transmission level remains high in Waupaca County today.

Since we last updated you on February 22, we have had 2 employees test positive for COVID-19. Accounting for recent employee and member recoveries, currently we have 3 cases of COVID-19 on campus (0 members, 3 employees).

The CDC and Wisconsin Department of Health Services continue to recommend vaccines and booster shots for everyone over the age of 12. Boosters and additional COVID-19 vaccine doses are crucial in the fight against this virus and the highly contagious Omicron variant.
