



Visiting Members at the Wisconsin Veterans Home at Union Grove

Beginning **Monday, March 22, 2021**, you will be able to visit your member in their room! We are thrilled to be able to welcome you back. Everyone here is excited to see our family and friends back on campus.

Below are the campus visit guidelines. Guidelines apply to all visitors and visits regardless of an individual's vaccination status.

- In room visits can occur for any member, regardless of vaccination status, who are not on precautions due to an illness or required quarantine period.
- In room visits can occur any day of the week and at any time and can last for any duration of time. Visitors can come and go from the facility as they need.
- Upon arrival, please use the hand sanitizer provided. Visitors will then be required to sign-in using the Kiosk and will be offered a COVID test prior to visiting. Please sign out when you leave.
- Visitors must follow the CDC's Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Prevention including:
 - Screening for signs and symptoms of COVID-19
 - Hand hygiene
 - Face covering or mask, covering mouth and nose, at all times
 - Social distancing of at least six feet between persons
 - If two weeks has passed since the member received his/her 2nd COVID vaccine, physical touch can occur.
 - If touching occurs, both member and guest must perform hand hygiene before and after touching for safety.
 - Please ensure families always keep six feet of distance from other members and staff.
- Gates Hall visitors:
 - Please sign in at the Boland Hall entrance. To limit the traffic inside the facility, we then respectfully request you drive to the Gates Hall entrance after screening and enter the building there.
- Outdoor visits can take place, weather permitting.

Please follow these guidelines so we can make sure we continue to do all we can to ensure that we can continue to have these kind of visits indefinitely.
