Since we last updated you on Monday (5/10), we have had one employee test positive for COVID-19. We currently have two cases of COVID-19 on campus (2 employees, 0 members).

Per the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), we continue facility-wide COVID-19 testing for staff and members. Because this employee does not have direct contact with members, we are able to continue to allow in-room visits at this time. Earlier this week, we had two consecutive days without COVID-19 deaths in Wisconsin. And while that is very encouraging, we want to urge you to please continue to wear a mask when out, remain six feet away from others, avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces, wash your hands frequently, and get vaccinated.
