Despite low transmission levels, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) is reporting a higher spread and impact of COVID-19 across our state over the past two weeks. Since we last updated you on May 20, we have had 1 employee test positive for COVID-19. Accounting for all recent recoveries, currently we have 5 cases of COVID-19 on campus (0 members, 4 employees).

If you are planning to visit our campus, all visitors are asked to wear an N95 or KN95 mask when in our buildings and perform a health check assessment upon arriving.
