Dear King Members, Friends, and Family:

Today, I write again to update you on COVID-19. Sadly, since the pandemic began, there have been over 651,000 confirmed cases and nearly 7,600 deaths in Wisconsin. We are hopeful that if everyone does their part we can stop the spread of this terrible disease.

Since we last updated you on August 18, 2021 we have had one employee test positive for COVID-19. There are currently three cases (zero members, three employees) of COVID-19 on campus.

Per the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), we continue with facility-wide COVID-19 testing and limiting visitation. (As a reminder, it is always best to call ahead or visit [www.WisVetsHomesCOVID.com](http://www.WisVetsHomesCOVID.com) to confirm which member units are open before traveling for a visit.)

I continue to ask you to please get vaccinated if you have if you haven't been already. As always, please continue to adhere to the guidance set by the Centers for Disease Control when it comes to face coverings, social distancing, and hand washing.
