Dear King Members, Friends, and Family:

COVID-19 cases in Wisconsin nursing homes are increasing as we see a surge in cases across the state. According to data from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, nursing homes in Wisconsin are reporting the highest number of positive tests for the virus since January.

Since we last updated you on September 9, we have had one employee test positive for COVID-19. Currently we have two cases of COVID-19 on campus, both employees.

Over the weekend the state Department of Health Services reported that about two-thirds of Wisconsin adults have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. We hope you are among them. We know that the vaccine can help us prevent the spread of COVID-19, a virus which can have a devastating impact on our vulnerable populations.

I continue to ask you to please get vaccinated if you haven't been already. The Delta variant is proving especially contagious. As always, please continue to adhere to the guidance set by the Centers for Disease Control when it comes to face coverings, social distancing, and hand washing.
