Volgistics, is our new automated volunteer tracking system that is now available for you to use and interact with. With Volgistics, you can access all your volunteer information. You'll be able to enter your volunteer hours right from the comfort of your home using your cell-phone, tablet, computer, iPad, etc. There is also a computer located in the Volunteer Office if you would like to access your profile and log volunteer hours while here at King.
