The class is interactive providing for many different learning styles. This course is appropriate for all professionals who work with clients with dementia; front line caregivers, Social workers, RN's, hospice and home health, activity therapists, managers, and more. Several of the units cover federal regulatory key points. These regulations are F740: Behavioral health services, F742: Treatment/service for mental/Psychosocial concerns, F757: Drug regimen is free from unnecessary drugs, F741: Sufficient/competent staff behavioral health needs and F744: Treatment/service for dementia.
