Chair Paul Fisk called the meeting to Order at 10:31am. Roll call was taken, 16 members in attendance; a quorum was present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes from December 19, 2024 were reviewed:

• MOTION: George Banda made a motion to approve the minutes, second by Phil Landgraf; minutes were unanimously approved.

Executive Staff Assistant Dawn LaFond provided an Administrative Update.

Senate Veteran Committee Chair Andre Jacque provided information and updates on a number of veteran related bills that he is working on:

- <u>2025 Senate Bill 134</u>: Alternative open enrollment application procedures for residency change based on military orders.
  - $\circ~$  A public hearing on the bill was scheduled for 04.03.2025 at 1:30pm in Room 411 South
- [Not Introduced Yet] Expanding eligibility under the veterans and surviving spouses property tax credit to allow those with disability ratings of 70 percent or greater to claim the credit,
  - Stand alone or added as a budget motion
- [Not Introduced Yet] Occupational Licensure Interstate Compacts to create seamless licensure portability for all members of a profession, including military spouses and service members

Assistant Deputy Secretary Joseph Hoey provided updates to the Council covering the following topics:

- Highlights of Governor Ever's FY2025-FY2027 Budget <u>2025-27 Capital Budget Agency Requests and</u> <u>Governor's Recommendations</u>, including:
  - Increased funding for CVSOs/TVSOs
  - Additional GPR dollars for the Veterans Outreach Program (VORP) to remain at the expanded 16 region level versus 11 regions
  - o Increased funding for the Operation of the Veterans Housing and Recovery Program (VHRP)
  - Funding for new VHRP Facilities in Chippewa Falls (\$14.3M) and Green Bay (\$10.0M)
  - New kitchen and laundry facility at King Veterans Home (\$101.4M)
  - \$6.2M for the preliminary planning and design of the new Wisconsin Veterans Museum
  - Expansion of the veterans and surviving spouses property tax credit
    - Overview of credit can be found at <u>Veterans and Surviving Spouses Property Tax Credit</u> (Informational Paper 14)
  - $\circ$  \$1M for the University of Wisconsin MIA Project
